MEMORANDUM ORDER NO. 002-04-2021-A

TO : NTC CENTRAL OFFICE AND REGIONAL OFFICES
ALL CONCERNED

SUBJECT : EXTENDING THE VALIDITY OF NTC ISSUED PERMITS,
CERTIFICATES AND LICENSES EXPIRING DURING THE
PERIOD 22 MARCH 2021 TO 30 JUNE 2021

In the interest of public service and subject to the strict prerequisite of a valid and subsisting legislative franchise, if applicable, all existing radio operator certificates, permits, certificates and licenses to operate communications equipment, networks and facilities, public, government or private, in various radio services such as but not limited to broadcast, fixed and land mobile, amateur, aeronautical, maritime, satellite, special services, including permits and accreditation issued to manufacturers/ dealers/ suppliers/ retailers/ resellers/service centers of radio equipment and devices and certificates of registration as value-added service providers, issued by the National Telecommunications Commission, expiring within the period from **22 March 2021 to 30 June 2021** shall continue to be valid until **31 August 2021**.

Subject strictly to the prerequisite of a valid and subsisting legislative franchise, if applicable, holders of the above-mentioned certificates, permits and licenses may file for the renewal of their certificates, permits and licenses **within the same period or until 31 August 2021**, without penalties or surcharges. Thereafter, appropriate penalties/surcharges shall be imposed for late filing of its renewal.

This Order shall apply only to those entities whose legislative franchises, if applicable, are valid and subsisting for the duration of the entire period covered by this Order.

Further, this Order shall not apply to renewal/extension of certificates of public convenience and necessity (CPCN), certificates of public convenience (CPC), certificate of authority (CA) and provisional authority (PA) granted by the Commission in the exercise of its quasi-judicial power.

This Order supersedes Memorandum Order No. 002-04-2021.
