OFFICE ORDER
NO. 65-06-2009

SUBJECT : SIMPLIFIED PROCEDURES IN SECURING TYPE APPROVAL/ACCEPTANCE CERTIFICATES AND IN THE ISSUANCE OF EQUIPMENT CONFORMITY IN THE EQUIPMENT STANDARDS DIVISION (ESD).

Pursuant to Republic Act (RA) 9485, otherwise known as "The Anti-Red Tape Act" and Section I of this Commission's Memorandum Circular 02-01-2001, and in order to streamline and simplify further the requirements and procedures in the issuance of Type Approval Certificate, Type Acceptance Certificate and Grant of Equipment Conformity, the following guidelines and procedures shall be observed:

- I. FOR INDOOR WIRELESS NETWORK DEVICES (WDN), LOW POWER SHORT RANGE DEVICES (SRDs), LOW POWER RADIO FREQUENCY IDENTIFICATION DEVICES (RFIDs), CELLULAR MOBILE PHONES, AND OTHER LOW-POWER RF DEVICES.

The following minimum requirements shall be submitted:

1. Certificate of Conformity/Compliance and Test Report issued by a foreign regulator or conformity assessment or notified body, together with accredited laboratory, stating compliance with internationally accepted standards for Electromagnetic Compatibility (EMC) and Radio Frequency (RF) Efficiency.
2. In lieu of the above, a Manufacturer's Self-Declaration of Conformity (SDoC) shall be considered subject to: (a) submission of certification that the device/equipment has been applied with and accepted by pertinent certifying bodies, (b) submission of test reports done by any accredited laboratory/testing body certifying compliance with international standards of EMC and RF Efficiency, and (c) the URL/website of the bodies concerned should be indicated for verification of submitted information.
3. Equipment description/brochure indicating the technical specifications and block diagram of network connectivity.

II. CUSTOMER PREMISES EQUIPMENT (CPEs) with WIRED and/or DIRECT CONNECTION TO THE PUBLIC SWITCHED TELEPHONE NETWORK (PSTN).

The following minimum requirements shall be submitted:

1. Equipment description/brochure indicating the technical specifications and block diagram of network connectivity.
2. Certification and test report issued by a foreign regulator or conformity assessment body or accredited laboratory stating compliance with interface standards.

The certificate and/or grant shall be subject to the following conditions:

- a. Any change/modification of the circuitry and/or specifications of the equipment shall render the certificate/grant null and void.
- b. The certificate/grant shall be cancelled if it is found that the operation of the equipment causes harmful interference to existing radio communications systems or to the network of local PSTN operators.
- c. The certificate/grant is issued on the condition that the Grantee complies with and continues to comply with the requirements and provisions of pertinent laws, rules and regulations.

Orders, memoranda and guidelines inconsistent herewith are deemed superseded.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
