<p>The following are queries, clarifications, and request received on the procurement project:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>The required air conditioning units are not off-the-shelf (on stock) and some will be sourced from abroad and takes some time to ship to the Philippines especially this pandemic. Hence, we would like to request a completion period be extended from 30 calendar days to 90 calendar days.</li></ol> <p>Section VI Schedule of Requirements As most of the prospective bidders have voiced out, the 30 calendar days is not enough not only because of installation of aircon and electricals but also due to DELIVERIES of aircon suppliers equipments and restorations. Can you extend deadline?</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>Are we allowed to work during office hours (0800 HR - 1700 HR) and during night time (1700 HR - 0500 HR) including Saturdays and Sundays? Please clarify.</li><li>Are feedlines be provided by the winning contractor?</li><li>Per item V.I.B.14 of the Terms of Reference (TOR), are we require to submit a Certificate of Product Existence from the Air Conditioning Equipment supplier stating that the offered brand is used for at least five (5) years in the Philippine market? Kindly advise.</li><li>Please advise location of dismantled equipment.</li><li>Will you accept as Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) a Supply and Installation of Packaged and Inverter Type Air Handling Unit (AHU)?</li></ol>	<p><b>Completion period is extended to 45 calendar days</b></p> <p><b>Yes, you may work from 8am to 5pm during office hours, 5pm to 10pm after office hours and 8am to 10pm during Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays.</b></p> <p><b>Yes</b></p> <p><b>Yes, you are required to submit aCertificate of Product Existence from manufacturer/supplier/distributor.</b></p> <p><b>See attached Proposal for Capital Outlay 2</b></p> <p><b>No</b></p>

<p>7. Warranty In the aircon industry, there is not a single supplier who can give 3 years warranty on PCB for any FLOOR MOUNTED of any brand. It is only for split wall mounted units that a certain supplier offers 3 years on PCB.</p> <p>For a total of 20 units of Floor Mounted and PCB costing from 20,000 to 40,000 pesos, it would be very costly for any contractor to shoulder the remaining 2 years of warranty assuming 3 years is enforced.</p> <p>Can you just follow the one (1) year PCB warranty for Floor mounted being offered by all the suppliers?</p> <p>8. Section VI Schedule of Requirements Supply of 48 units, floor mounted (20 units) and wall mounted (28 units)</p> <p>For as long as the units comply with the specifications and at least Energy Star 4.0, can a contractor supply with a mixture of DIFFERENT BRANDS, to meet with the deadline?</p> <p>9. The supplier shall supply air conditioners which fulfills at least ENERGY STAR 4.0</p> <p>Is this ENERGY STAR 4.0 the latest Energy Efficiency measurement method, which is equivalent to Cooling Seasonal Performance Factor (CSPF)?</p> <p>ENERGY STAR 4.0 &gt;&gt;&gt;&gt;&gt; CSPF* or CSPF 4 STAR</p>	<p><b>Yes, the one (1) year PCB warranty for floor mounted air conditioners only, will be followed.</b></p> <p><b>Yes</b></p> <p><b>Please refer to DOE Department Circular No. DC2020-06-0015 dated June 15, 2020, and its Implementing Guidelines dated May 11, 2021.</b></p>
